Turner Farm Day Camp

For children ages 8 (by the day of camp--no exceptions) to age 10

Have you ever planted a tiny lettuce seed, pulled a long orange carrot from the ground, or found a fresh egg? Turner Farm invites children to experience life on a working farm and to discover through hands-on activities the way our food connects us to the soil, sun, water, and to each other.

Turner Farm Junior Farmer Day Camp

For children ages 11 (by the day of camp--no exceptions) to age 14

Like the regular farm day camp, this camp invites children to experience life on a working farm. It builds on the experience, by working with the products and resources on the farm, such as food, draft animals, farm equipment and wool.

Turner Farm Woodworking Day Camp

For children ages 9-12

(children younger than 9 only by permission of the instructor)

Using wood from our own forest, campers will begin to identify types of wood and the properties that make each species unique and suitable for different applications. The campers will learn about how to select and cut a piece of raw wood for a project and then, using hand tools, fashion their very own project, as well as a project useful to the farm.
