



## Introduction to Horse Driving

This class will help students gain confidence in working with horses on the farm.

Participants will learn the basics of harnessing, hitching and driving, specifically:

- the function of all parts of the harness
- how to harness
- ground driving single horse
- hitching single horse
- driving single horse
- basics of driving a team

Upon completion of this course and a demonstration of driving comfort and skill (for a novice, we would recommend 20 or 30 driving hours), participants will be eligible for additional classes on using horses for farm or forest tasks.

This three-day class can take up to six participants. The fee per student is \$150\*. Participants must be at least 12 years of age. No prior experience is necessary. Our belgian draft horses are well behaved and respond well to people, but basic safety will be emphasized.

Classes meet on Friday evening from 7-9 pm, on Saturday from 9 am-5 pm and on Sunday from 1-5 pm  
(bring a lunch for Saturday)
